

Tableau Desktop Free Edition Supplement

Use of Tableau Desktop Free Edition is subject to the Free Services terms of the Salesforce online [Main Subscription Agreement](#) (“**MSA**”) and the supplemental terms set forth below (“**Supplement**”). This Supplement adjusts certain terms of the MSA, solely with respect to use of Tableau Desktop Free Edition Products. Except as adjusted herein, all terms and conditions set forth in the MSA shall continue to apply in full force and effect. Capitalized terms used but not defined in this Supplement have the meanings given to them in the MSA.

For the sake of clarity, where Customer has purchased Tableau Products under an Order Form with Salesforce, the terms and conditions of that Order Form and the MSA referenced therein apply to such purchased Tableau Products and the terms of this Supplement do not apply.

BY CLICKING THE BOX INDICATING ACCEPTANCE OF THE MSA AND THIS SUPPLEMENT CUSTOMER AGREES TO THE TERMS OF THIS SUPPLEMENT AND THE MSA. IF THE INDIVIDUAL ACCEPTING THIS SUPPLEMENT AND THE MSA IS ACCEPTING ON BEHALF OF A COMPANY OR OTHER LEGAL ENTITY, SUCH INDIVIDUAL REPRESENTS THAT THEY HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO BIND SUCH ENTITY AND ITS AFFILIATES TO THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS, IN WHICH CASE THE TERM “**CUSTOMER**” SHALL REFER TO SUCH ENTITY AND ITS AFFILIATES. IF THE INDIVIDUAL ACCEPTING THIS AGREEMENT DOES NOT HAVE SUCH AUTHORITY, OR DOES NOT AGREE WITH THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS, SUCH INDIVIDUAL MUST NOT ACCEPT THIS AGREEMENT AND MAY NOT USE THE SOFTWARE. The Software may not be accessed for purposes of monitoring its availability, performance or functionality, or for any other benchmarking or competitive purposes.

SFDC’s direct competitors are prohibited from accessing the Services, except with SFDC’s prior written consent.

This Supplement was last updated on March 2, 2026. It is effective between Customer and SFDC as of the date of Customer’s accepting this Supplement (the “**Effective Date**”).

1. **Definitions.** In addition to the definitions within the MSA, the following definitions apply:

“**Tableau Desktop Free Edition Software**” or “**Free Software**” means those Free Services (as such term is defined in the MSA) which are designated as Tableau Desktop Free Edition Software, together with any Updates that may be made available, comprising a limited functionality version of purchased Tableau Services, that is made available for download online at www.tableau.com and/or other web pages designated by SFDC or one of its Affiliates, for deployment on Customer’s premises or on Customer’s third party hosting provider as may be permitted in the Documentation, and all related Documentation for and any maintenance releases of the same Free Software.

“**Documentation**” as defined in the MSA includes the documentation found at www.tableau.com/legal/documentation which applies to Free Software. All undefined names of Tableau Products have the meanings given to them in the Documentation.

2. **Open Source Software.** Free Software may contain or be provided with components which are licensed from third parties including components subject to open source software licenses (“**Open Source Software**”). Open Source Software may be identified in the Documentation, or in a list of the Open Source Software provided to Customer upon written request. To the extent required by the license that accompanies the Open Source Software, the terms of such license will apply in lieu of the terms of this Supplement with respect to such Open Source Software, including, without limitation, any provisions governing access to source code, modification or reverse engineering.

3. **Registration, activation, and connectivity.** Use of the Free Software requires each User to have a valid TableauID (or successor SFDC identity) and to obtain a software authorization issued by SFDC for the Free Software as described in the Documentation (“**Software Authorization**”). Customer shall ensure that each Software Authorization issued by SFDC is associated with a single uniquely identified User and used in accordance with the Documentation. The Free Software may only be activated and used on devices that have internet connectivity sufficient to register with SFDC’s licensing and identity services, and SFDC is not obligated to support any offline activation or use that bypasses such registration. SFDC may set a maximum duration or expiration date for any Software Authorization issued for the Free Software and may require Users to periodically reconnect to SFDC’s licensing services in order to maintain continued access.

4. **Updates.** SFDC may, in its sole discretion, make new releases or versions of the Free Software available from time to time (“**Updates**”). SFDC may require Customer and its Users to install and use a particular minimum or current version of the Free Software as a condition of continued access to the Free Software, and may disable or limit access to older versions. Customer acknowledges that continued availability and functionality of the Free Software may depend on installing such updates and using a currently supported version as described in the Documentation.

5. Software License. Subject to all of the terms and conditions of this Supplement and the MSA, SFDC grants to Customer a limited, worldwide, non-transferable, non-sublicensable, non-exclusive license to use the Free Software for which Customer has been issued a Software Authorization by SFDC for Customer's own internal business operations, but only in accordance with: (a) the Documentation; (b) the MSA; and (c) and all terms set forth in this Supplement. Subject to the foregoing, Customer may allow Users to connect to certain data sources and to save content locally in supported file formats, as described in the Documentation. Customer's license to Free Software may be subject to additional restrictions as set forth in the Documentation or as otherwise designated by SFDC. Unless otherwise set forth in the Documentation, Customer may copy and install on Customer's computers for use only by Customer's Users one copy of the Free Software for each User's sole individual use.

6. Usage Restrictions. In addition to the Usage Restrictions in the MSA, and as a condition of Customer's license, Customer shall not (and shall not allow any third party) to: (a) circumvent any restrictions, usage limits or licensing requirements applicable to Customer's use of any paid Tableau Products, or provide an alternative distribution mechanism for Tableau Content (including, without limitation, emailing, file transferring, or placing files on shared network storage for access by others) in lieu of other licensed Tableau Products; (b) use any equipment, device, software, or other means designed to circumvent or remove any Software Authorization or copy protection used by SFDC in connection with the Free Software, or use the Free Software together with any authorization code, product key, credential, serial number, or other copy protection device not supplied by SFDC; (c) use the Free Software to provide services, dashboards, reports, or other outputs to, or for the benefit of, any third party, including any Customer client, vendor or affiliate thereof; (d) use the Free Software to develop a product that converts any SFDC file format to an alternative report file format used by any general-purpose report writing, data analysis or report delivery product that is not the property of SFDC; (e) connect to or interact with Tableau Server or Tableau Cloud (including without limitation connecting to published data sources or publishing workbooks, data sources or other content); (f) remove any product identification, proprietary, copyright, trademark, service mark, or other notices contained in the Free Software; (g) use the Free Software in a way that could lead to death or bodily injury of any person, or to severe physical or environmental damage (the limitations of liability in the MSA shall not apply to breaches of this section); or, (h) open, modify, or use within the Free Software any Tableau file, workbook, dashboard or data source ("**Tableau Content**") that was created, authored, or saved by any person other than the specific User authorized to use the Free Software; or share, distribute, transfer, or otherwise make available any Tableau Content created within the Free Software to any other person or entity, including other Users within Customer's organization. For clarity, sharing of insights derived from the Free Software is restricted to static, non-interactive formats (e.g., screenshots, PDF exports) that do not allow the recipient to access the underlying data or analysis structures. The prohibitions in this Section apply regardless of whether the Software technically prevents such actions.

7. Usage Certification. Upon SFDC's written request, no more than once annually, Customer shall furnish SFDC with a signed statement certifying that the Free Software is being used pursuant to the terms of the MSA and this Supplement, including any access and User limitations, and provide a current list of Users. If SFDC reasonably believes Customer has violated the MSA or this Supplement, SFDC may review Customer's use of the Free Software, and Customer's software monitoring systems and records, provided such review occurs during regular business hours and SFDC provides reasonable prior notice. If the review reveals non-compliance, SFDC shall, in addition to its rights under the MSA, have the right to either require Customer to comply or terminate access to the Free Software.

8. Customer Data. Customer acknowledges that electronic data and information submitted by or for Customer to the Free Software is not hosted by or on behalf of SFDC. Accordingly, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the MSA, any terms or commitments relating to Customer Data (or Your Data, or any comparable defined term) under the MSA shall not apply with respect to the Free Software.

9. Export Compliance. In addition to the Export Compliance requirements in the MSA, Customer shall not allow any third party to export, re-export, or transfer any part of the Free Software in violation of the export compliance provisions of the MSA.
